Our wonderful P&C have been working very hard to prepare for the annual East Orange Village Markets, coming up this Sunday 16th October. A reminder that while we encourage everyone to come along to the markets, students from Orange East PS must be accompanied by a parent or carer if they attend the markets. Please note there will be no student supervision provided by staff on the day.

As we finally start to feel some warmer weather, a reminder that during Term 4 it is compulsory for students to wear their maroon school bucket hat while playing in the playground, as well as during PE and Sport. From Wednesday students not wearing the correct hat will be restricted to playing

under the COLA/central lunch area. Also a reminder as we move to our summer uniform that we have a high expectation for all students to be in the correct uniform. Dress/ Tunic/ Shirt/ Pants/ Shorts <i>Girls</i>	Summer (Mon, Tues, Thurs, Fri) * <u>Preferred</u> : Tartan dress Or *White button up shirt with tartan shorts Sport (Wednesday) * Yellow polo shirt with maroon shorts/netball skirt (summer)
