Semester One Reports & Interviews

A reminder to please book parent/teacher interviews as soon as possible. Reminder letters went out last week for any families yet to make an appointment. So far 138 bookings have already been made!

To facilitate the booking of parent/teacher interviews we are using the *School Interviews* website.

1. Simply click the link below:

2. Enter the event code: **hmnqj**
3. The website will guide you through three simple steps, and moments later you'll get an email confirming your bookings.

Parents without internet or computer access are welcome to come in and use a specially set-up computer in the office or alternatively ring the school office for assistance. The *School Interviews* website has been live now for almost three weeks. It will close on Friday, 17th June.

Parent/teacher interviews will be 15 minutes long and take place across Weeks 9 and 10 (Mon, 20th June – Fri, 1st July). The student report will be provided to parents at the time of interview.

Later this week, an *Interview Confirmation sheet* will be sent home detailing when your interview is booked and also the location for the interview. Generally, most interviews will take place in your child's classroom, however as a number of interviews will occur in school hours we have had to organise alternative interview locations if the classroom is in use. The bottom of the

***Interview Confirmation sheet* will detail your interview location (including a school map). Please come via the school office if unsure of where to go in the school grounds. A reminder that interviews MUST start and stop according to booking times. In the case of an interview starting late, it will still finish at the prescribed time otherwise this will impact on all following bookings. We strongly suggest arriving early to ensure time to find a park and move to your interview location.**
