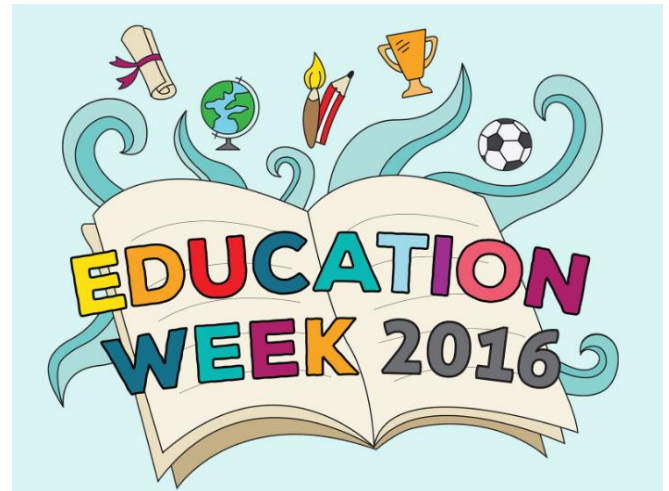

## *Education Week*

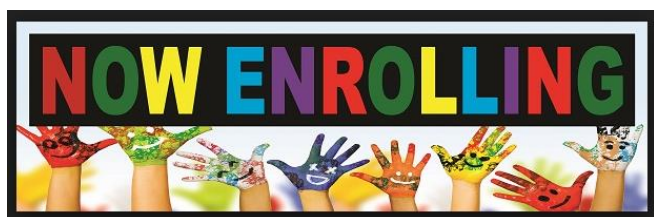
