**School Jackets** ~ orders are available for pick-up from school office.

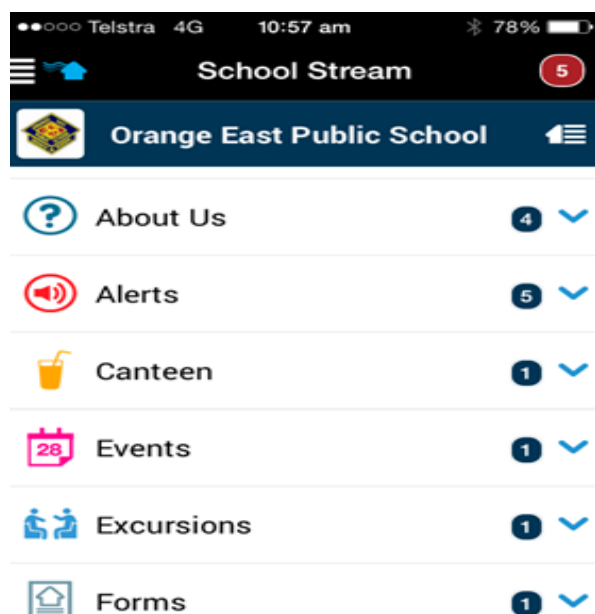
