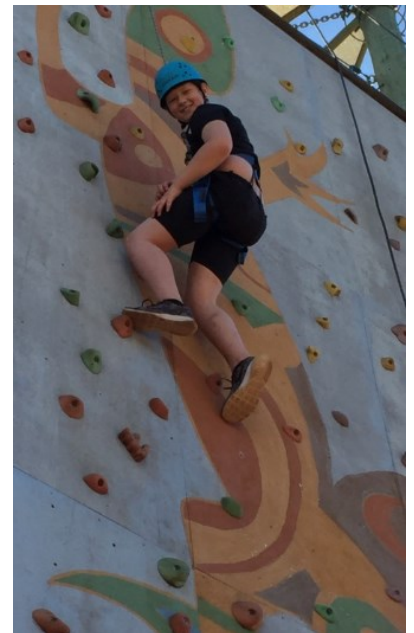
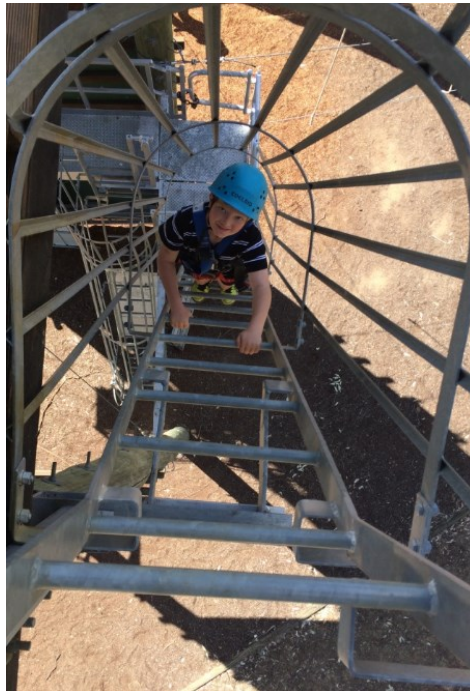

Stage 3 Burrendong Excursion

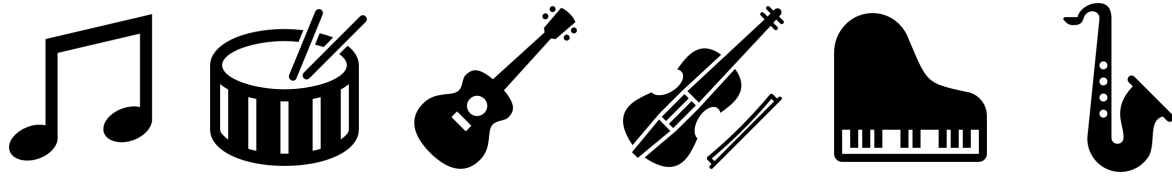
